## The Meeting that Saved My Son's Life

#### Dear (Client Advocate) Dana:

While rummaging through a box of notes and old photos, I recently came across a letter you sent to me with warm words, dated August 15, 2009. I was only 18 years old, pregnant, and scared when I met with you at Pregnancy Center East. During the appointment, you were very compassionate and informative, and you gave me a little silicone baby that was approximately the size of my unborn baby at the time. I kept that little silicone baby and went into deep thinking about how the rest of my life would be, with or without this child.

Ultimately, I decided to keep my son and he was born in March 2010. I named him Cody\*. Everything about his birth was fine, but he was born with a congenital kidney tumor that was later removed when he was six months old. Since then, he has been a healthy active child.

I have been a single mom his entire life and unfortunately, he has no connection to his father. However, he has me and my mother who acts as if she is his other parent. Cody has been the light of my world, and although I didn't

end up doing all the things I aspired in life, he changed me in ways I could never imagine. The name Cody means "helper". In fact, he has helped me get a bachelor's degree in business, and now I'm working on my bachelor's in nursing. He has helped me run my own business and every day gives me the motivation to keep going and stay strong. It has been a hard journey as a

single mom, but he makes it worth it.

Thank you for your kindness and for inspiring me to keep him. I hope all is well with you. You will always have a special place in Cody's and my heart even though we only met once almost a decade ago.

#### Dear Fellow Pro-life Friends of PCE,

"Save the life of the ONE CHILD!" exhorted Mike Huckabee at our recent *Banquet for Life*. Reaching to grasp the hands of the ONE: the ONE CHILD, the ONE MOTHER, the ONE FATHER.

Our PCE Shared Goal: Abortion vulnerable mothers and fathers will choose life and hope rather than abortion and despair, experiencing God's love through us, and help to find success in their life plan.

With Ohio's passage of the historic **Heartbeat Bill**, PCE remains steadfast in our 37-year ministry showing "true pro-life concern" for all babies born in Ohio. Despite years of road blocks/anti-life propaganda inflicted by abortion industry supporters, "The country's 2,750 pro-life pregnancy help centers seem to be the best-kept secret of the pro-life movement...

to end abortion...they quietly go about their life-saving work each and every day... In 2017 alone, they served nearly 2 million people with free services, an estimated community cost savings of at least \$161 million." (Pregnancy-HelpNews.com)

By contrast, we were horrified by the barbaric NY law that an unborn child may be murdered all nine months in New York, as no medical protections need be given to newborns who survive abortions; likewise, outrageously permitting non-physicians to commit abortions! Governor Cuomo and abortion industry supporters cheered, lighting up a "Pink" NY City in their macabre delight! Birthday Abortion and infanticide are also being considered in Virginia, Vermont and New Mexico.

"On Feb. 25, the U.S. Senate failed to pass the Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act by a vote of 53-44, falling 7 votes short of the needed 60. Sponsored by Sen. Ben Sasse (R. NE) and cosponsored by 49 of his fellow Republican senators including Ohio US Sen. Portman, it would have required doctors, in the case of an infant born alive after a failed abortion, to provide medical care to that living newborn baby, as would be provided to any wanted newborn baby of the same age." Until 1973, children and their mothers were protected...until the Supreme Court legalized abortion! Other heinous Supreme Court decisions have been overturned: the infamous Dred Scott decision supporting human beings treated as someone's property, the curse of slavery.
