An "Accidental" Call

I picked up the phone on the second ring. Although our Center had closed, I answered as we provide 24/7 hotline coverage.

The voice on the other line was frantic. A young woman had called us, thinking she had reached the after-hours line of an abortion clinic. She had taken the abortion pill (RU486) two weeks ago and was at a department store when she suddenly began to hemorrhage. She was in the bathroom of the store, alone, terrified of what was happening to her.

This call is not unique at Pregnancy Center East. While both chemical and surgi-





cal abortions carry risks (including death), chemical abortions account for the majority of complications. In fact, the risk of experiencing a significant medical complication from a chemical abortion is four times higher than complications from a surgical abortion, and the most common is hemorrhage.

This is due largely to the fact that the restrictions placed on the abortion pill have grown more lax over the years. Critical medical supervision has also largely diminished, with women taking the pills alone at home in many cases. The result is a dangerous procedure that leaves many women isolated and suffering.

In the case of this evening caller, she was left terrified in a store restroom. I did my best to calm her down and understand the situation. "A franic young woman had called us, thinking she had reached the after-hours line of an abortion clinic. She had taken the abortion pill two weeks earlier and began to hemorrhage. She was in the store bathroom alone and terrified of what was happening to her."

An ambulance transported her to the closest emergency room. I called her the next after– noon to check in—she was doing better and had been released from the hospital.

I discovered she had a one-year-old baby and invited them to come in for diapers, wipes, clothes, and anything else she might need all free of charge. She agreed and said, "That is the best thing I've heard in the last twentyfour hours."

She left our center with bags filled with everything her baby needed as well as encouragement and resources for post-abortion healing.

As she was leaving, she said she was glad she "accidentally" called us. I told her that I was, too.

She learned about our many outstanding complimentary services which now to her delight includes an adoption agency on site.

When she heard we are located across from Madison Bowl she beamed, "I know where that is...I've been to that building across the street!" Formerly the Talbert House, I explained we bought that building, totally renovated it, and "you'll love it!" A baby and family found an Oasis of HOPE in a trusted place of PCE!

I Was 19 When I Found Out I Was Pregnant...

Dear Pregnant Woman:

I've been where you are. I was 19 when I found out I was pregnant. My boyfriend made it very clear that we were not getting married. He pushed for an abortion. I contemplated suicide. How could this be happening? It was 1980. Times were a little different, but I'm sure you're just as scared, nervous and unsure of what to do as I was.

I caved in -I had the abortion. 40 years later, I can still remember it all. I remember praying the *Hail Mary* and asking for forgiveness while it was happening. I remember spiraling out of control in the months afterwards, alcohol, drugs, depression, another pregnancy. My boyfriend left, but I kept my second baby.

It took me years to get my life turned around; to get employed and support myself and my son. But there was always something missing.



My heart and soul were crushed by my decision to abort my first child. I have battled with depression for years.

I've finally returned to the Catholic Church and have confessed my sin of abortion. I have

received absolution but still struggle to forgive myself.

I'm reaching out to you, hoping that my pain and experience can help prevent you from experiencing the same.

Ultimately, this will be your decision. I ask that you fully consider how your choice today may affect you for the rest of your life. I certainly didn't think I would suffer my entire life from this one decision.

I will pray for you, no matter what decision you make regarding your pregnancy.

Trust the people at Pregnancy Center East. They will give you the best information possible. I only wish PCE had been around 40 years ago to offer me the help I needed to choose life for my baby.
