

Director of Chastity Education With the support from a small group of outside donors, Keith Warnke, the Theology of the Body Youth Program Director at Ruah Woods and I were blessed to conduct a week-long mission trip to the country of Belize. We focused on introducing teens and educators to St. John Paul II's transformational teaching about life and love, called the Theology of the Body. The joint effort allowed us to speak to over 3,000 teenagers, distribute thousands of books and resources, and form connections with pro-life leaders across the country. We also filmed an hour long television program promoting the integration of Theology of the Body into the Belizean school religion curriculum. Our chastity presentations marked the commencement of Belizean schools standing up to the radical anti-Christian values being forced on their country by the likes of Planned Parenthood Global.

Teachers and administrators were overjoyed to hear that chastity was being added to their curriculum because their students are facing difficult challenges. One principal told me that several of her female students have fallen victim to sex trafficking. She described how the process works: The student receives a text message from the sex trafficker. She then sneaks out of school and gets into the trafficker's car. The trafficker takes the young student to a brothel and promptly returns her to school after her prostitution duties are completed. It's tragic

when a misguided youth's hunger for authentic love is hijacked by predatory and cultural influences.

Regardless of geography, youth are hungry for truth. Keith and I witnessed this hunger first-hand as teens gave standing ovations to the message of authentic love and chastity. Students rushed our resource tables after presentations to receive books on chastity and the dangers of pornography. Many stayed to share their personal struggles with us. We offered evening presentations for parents and teens who could not attend the daytime presentations. I was inspired by one teenage boy who heard our story at school and then brought his girlfriend to hear the presentation at night! This illustrates how open teens are to hearing the message of love and chastity.

We do a great disservice to them when we fail to lovingly share these truths. The politically correct, risk-reduction view of sex education strips the youth of responsibility and leads them into the wilderness of despair known as hedonism. However, when teens are given the message of authentic love tied with chastity, their lives take direction. Despair transforms into hope and the dignity of the human person is proclaimed. After all, despair is cured by the gift of a mission. Teens are desperately pleading for us to assign to them the mission of love. Thank you to all who lend their time, talents, and support for the youth served by Pregnancy Center East.
